## Required Software

- Flash Player 9 (recommended: the latest version of Flash Player)
  - You can download Flash at: <http://www.adobe.com/products/flashplayer/>
  - You can check your Flash version at:

  - You must have permissions to install an ActiveX control (IE browser only).
  - The Google toolbar that comes with Flash is not needed. It is recommended to unclick the toolbar box when installing.
- Fully supported browsers: **Windows:** Internet Explorer 6+ and Firefox 1.5+. **MAC:** Firefox 1.5+ and Safari 1.2+. Other browsers use Flash 9, but may not support all eDesign functionality.
- Adobe Acrobat Reader 5.0 or better (for PDF viewing). You can download Adobe Reader at: <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>

## Set browser cache at 200MB or above...

<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Open Internet Explorer.</li><li>2. Click the <b>Tools</b> menu.</li><li>3. Select <b>Internet Options</b>.</li><li>4. Click the <b>General</b> tab.</li><li>5. Click <b>Settings</b> in the Browsing History section.</li><li>6. Change Disk space to use to <b>200MB</b> or above.</li><li>7. Click <b>OK</b> to save changes.</li><li>8. Click <b>OK</b> again.</li><li>9. Close and restart the browser.</li></ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Open Safari.</li><li>2. Click the <b>Edit</b> menu (Win) or the <b>Safari</b> menu (Mac).</li><li>3. Click <b>Preferences</b>.</li><li>4. Click the <b>Security</b> tab.</li><li>5. ## Network Settings

- Pop-up blockers must allow the eDesign site URL. This includes third-party toolbars (such as Google or Yahoo) and security programs (such as Symantec).
- High speed internet connection (T1 or broadband). Check your speed and other parameters at: <http://BrowserTest.HJeDesign.com>
- It may be necessary to create an exception for the HJeDesign domain if content filtering or proxies interfere with internet communications.
- Optional tools. eDesign partners with services at other web addresses outside of the HJeDesign.com URL. eDesign itself will work fine if your school blocks all web addresses that haven't been explicitly approved, but you may not be able to access the following:
  - \* Picnik.com, used for redevye correction and other simple photo editing.
  - \* Aviary.com, used for changing photo backgrounds and other powerful photo edits.
  - \* Facebook.com, used to publish a Yearbook Sneak Peek and spread the word about Yearbooks.

## Other Requirements

- Uploaded images must be in the .jpg, .tif, .png, or .eps format.
- A single upload cannot exceed 200MB total.
- Minimum screen resolution of 1024 x 768 pixels.
